Beyond the 'Reclining Nude'

Carole Feuerman's work and its significance within Post Modern art in the United States will be examined in a two part presentation. First, Dr. Michael Tomor will provide a historic look at Western European sculpture, and the influence of hyperrealism and Pop Art, on Ms. Feuerman's work. Then, Christian Gerstheimer will lead a tour of the exhibition *Earth Water Air Fire* on view through November 7.

Michael A. Tomor, Ph.D. is the El Paso Museum of Art Director for the City of El Paso. Dr. Tomor received his Ph.D. in Art History from The Pennsylvania State University with an emphasis on 17th Century Spanish Baroque. Dr. Tomor received his M.A. and B.A. in Art History from The Pennsylvania State University. He has also served as the Binational Cultural Appointment for the Fundacion Carolina, Spanish Embassy, as Keynote Speaker, Role of Museums in Society, Encuentro Nacional de Artistas & Creadores, in Chihuahua City, Chihuahua and as Juror for the Quinto Concurso Binacional de Pintura, Museo de las Culturas del Norte, Paquime, Chihuahua. He has reviewed national grants for the National Endowment for the Humanities, American Association of Museums, and Institute of Museum and Library Services.
