



Contemporary Istanbul finishes with 67,000 visitors

Picasso's 'Nu allonge et tête d'homme de profil' sold for 1.9 million euros.

This year's Contemporary Istanbul has ended with 748 artists, 3,000 works and 22 countries. A total of 95 art galleries and 13 art spaces entered the fair. This year, 67 percent of the art work was sold and the value of the pieces at the fair reached to 180 million euros. A total of 67,000 people visited the contemporary art fair this year.

Picasso's "Nu allonge et tête d'homme de profil" work was sold for 1.9 million euros, while Andy Warhol's "Flowers" sold for 900,000 euros. Joan Miro's "Deux femmes dans la nuit" was sold for 390,000 euros and [Carole A. Feuerman's "Brooke with Beach Ball" sold for \\$275,000](#). Robert Longo's "Untitled (Shark 7)" sold for 350,000 euros.
